# Call Meeting to Order-

  - A. Monica, Michelle (Asst. Dir.), and Katie (Children's Librarian) went to ILA conference in Des Moines. Monica reported that the conference was very good.
  - B. Staff Development on Monday following the ILA seminar. Two board members attended as well as Mayor Soseman. A major takeaway was from the book "13 ways to kill a community".
  - C. Monica met with Crawford County Historical Society to put together a murder mystery event for on 2/13/21 and will be held at the Library. This is a Sunday. This will be a fundraiser put on by the Friends.
  - D. Monica had Trustee orientation with Michael Phipps.
  - E. Monica went to city council meeting and city planning session.
  - F. Management Team Meetings are continuing 2x per week.
  - G. Linda McCann held another event here and there were 12 attendees. The event was about the Civilian Conservation Corps.
  - H. Library has started Crafternoons on the first Friday of every month. The first one was October 1 and only had one attendee. The next one is in November.
  - I. Color Me Calm was on the 19th with 8 attendees.
  - J. Teen Programming involved tabletop role playing and this included four attendees. It will be put on again.
  - K. Katie is going to pre-schools for children's programming. There is Family Storytime, "My First Storytime" and bilingual story time.

- N. Library will be participating in the Market in the Park event at Washington Park on 10/30/21. The library is giving out a Halloween book for kids. There are 100 books and when they are out, we will pass out other books that we already have on hand.
- O. Meeting room usage has gone up this month. There have been 52 meetings serving 240 patrons.
- P. Fine Free Update this has been appreciated by the community. Folks with damaged or lost materials are still paying and can make payments.
- Q. Monica shared some results from the staff development day.
- R. Dean Fagen report Monica commented she did not see this from Terry Crawford in April because it went to her spam. She is now checking it more often.
- S. Mary Morgan is a local author who does book binding and she has asked to do a book binding class/tutorial. She's suggested a speaker's fee of \$50.00 and people who come would pay \$30.00 for their materials. The board is fine with her being paid as a speaker but not charging people for supplies; we'd prefer a demonstration-type of seminar.
- T. Monica would like the Board to consider a square-reader. This incurs a 3% charge for the transaction itself.
