- •Back door is still hard to open and not latching properly. Can be used as an emergency exit but not as an entrance.
- •Electrical upgrades would include additional outlets in the kitchen for a wall mounted flat screen TV, in the hall just outside kitchen, in the closets in the Carnegie meeting rooms and electrical power to the new water heater in the mechanics room on main floor. Funds allocated for many of these upgrades from the Baker gift were redirected with board approval on June 20<sup>th</sup>, 2023 to assist Denison Library Friends with funding a portion of the new conference table, thereby pulling funding for the electrical upgrades being planned.
