VIII. Unfinished Business:

- A. **Roof Repairs** Two bids have been received: a detailed bid from Premier Systems Roofing, Inc (Danbury, IA) for \$41,010.74 and a bid limited to shingles, underlayment, nails, and labor from Zuniga Construction (Denison, IA) for \$7,800. City Manager Garcia recommends a formal bidet on the city website with a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) moved by Donna, seconded by Jeri. motion passed
- **B. Library Custodian/Cleaning Contract** City Manager Garcia will forward the contract to the City Clerk for approval to amend the city budget before presenting it the City Council.
- C. Hiring Committee-Library Director The new Director, selected by the Hiring Committee Kari Meyer is introduced to the board and Friends of the Library by committee Chair Sandy Velasquez. Ms. Meyer requested a salary of \$65,700 (midpoint in our available salary range), 3 weeks paid vacation, and 5 days paid sick leave. Larry moves, Donna seconds approval of the request. motion passed. The board also expressed its thanks to Monica for her 13 years of outstanding service. The request will be presented at the City Council July 1 meeting for approval. Kari will start on July 7, 2025.

IX. New Business:

A. Policy Review-Job Description-Programming Librarian Michelle Hoffman will be stepping down from the position on November 3, 2025. The

programming librarian is a unique position in the Norelius Library and to most all libraries. It entails planning, coordinating, and overseeing all teen and adult programming. A job description was reviewed and will be approved at the July meeting.
